CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

AND NOW this 30th day of March, 2010, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is placed under Local Rule 16.1 for pretrial proceedings and all provisions of the Rule will be strictly enforced.

- 3. The parties shall complete discovery (factual **and** expert) by **August 26, 2010**. All interrogatories, depositions and requests for admissions and/or production of documents shall be served within sufficient time to allow responses to be completed **prior** to the close of

discovery, except that expert reports will be required as follows: Plaintiffs' expert report must be

filed by September 25, 2010 and Defendant's expert report must be filed by October 25, 2010.

The schedule for expert depositions will be addressed at the post-discovery status/settlement

conference.

4. The Court will conduct a post-discovery status/settlement conference on

September 13, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., in the Chambers of Chief United States Magistrate Judge

Amy Reynolds Hay, Ninth Floor, 9280 U.S. Post Office and Courthouse, 700 Grant Street,

Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Trial counsel shall attend and the parties shall be available by phone.

5. Motions for summary judgment must comply with Local Rule 56 and be filed by

November, 8, 2010. Responses to summary judgment motions must comply with Local Rule 56

and be filed by **December 8, 2010**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall follow this Court's Order on Motions

Practice in connection with all pretrial motions. The pendency of motions, including dispositive

motions, will not stay the time periods nor any compliance requirements of the Case

Management Order.
